For this, six rehearsals, a concert and two group lecturesclasses, and eleven individual sessions will be held by one of the most internationally recognized specialists: **Stefan Schulz**, member of the Berliner Philharmoniker and professor at the Universität der Künste Berlin.

Register for this fun day filled with masterclasses, performances, and demonstrations! Manufacturers will be attending and/or will have instruments available to try including:




