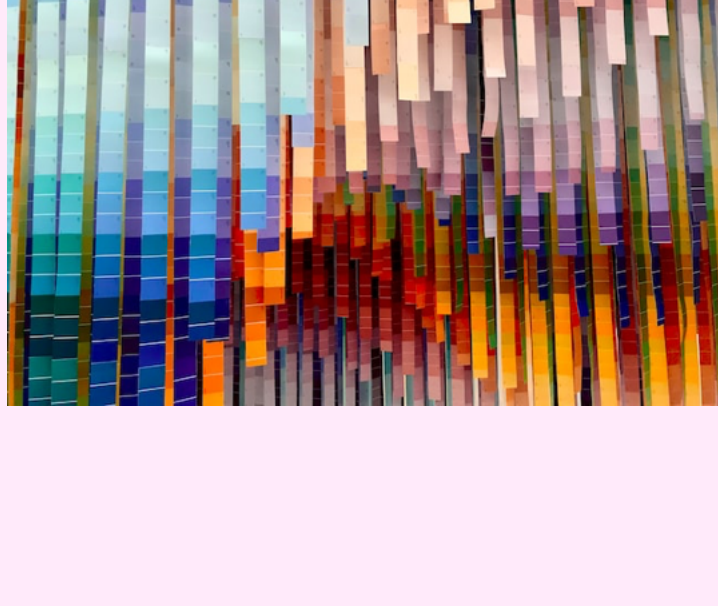

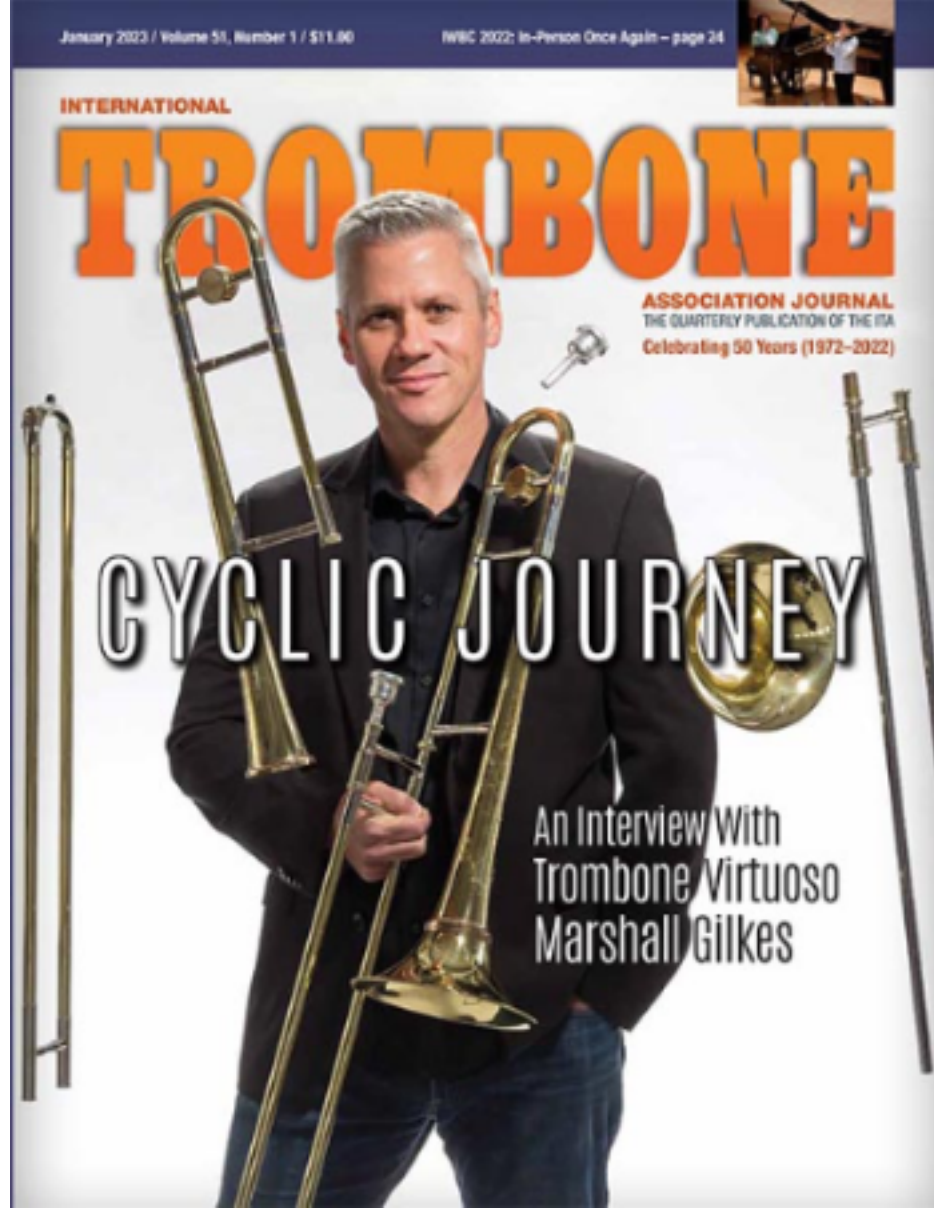

July 24-28 in Santa Fe, New Mexico. Featuring Brian Wendel, Principal Trombone of The Cleveland Orchestra.



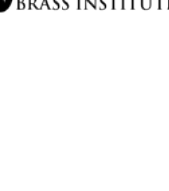
Third Coast Brass Retreat

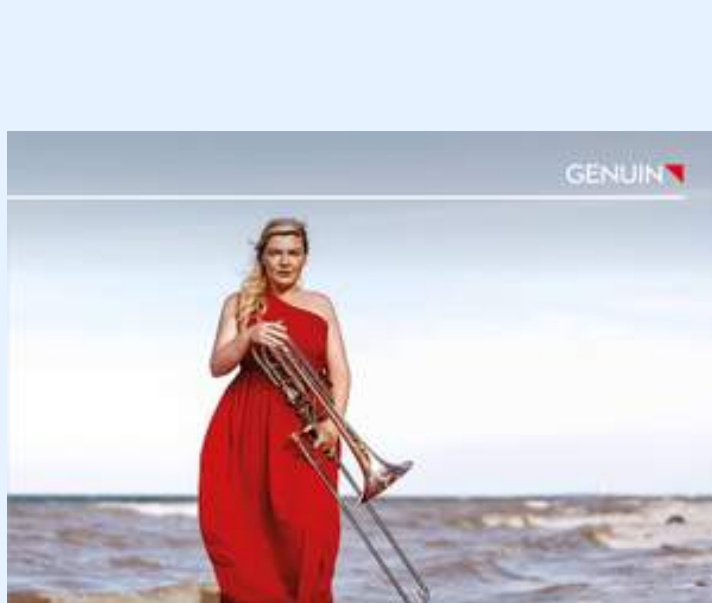
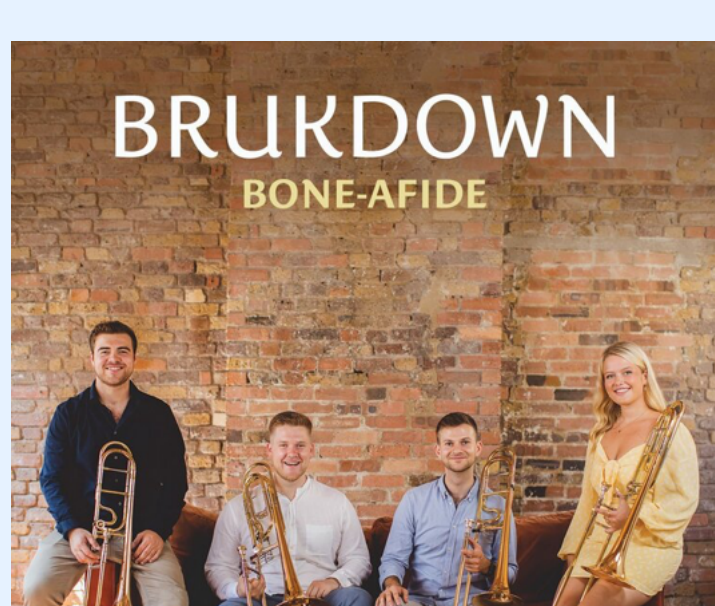
Rafael Mendez Brass Institute

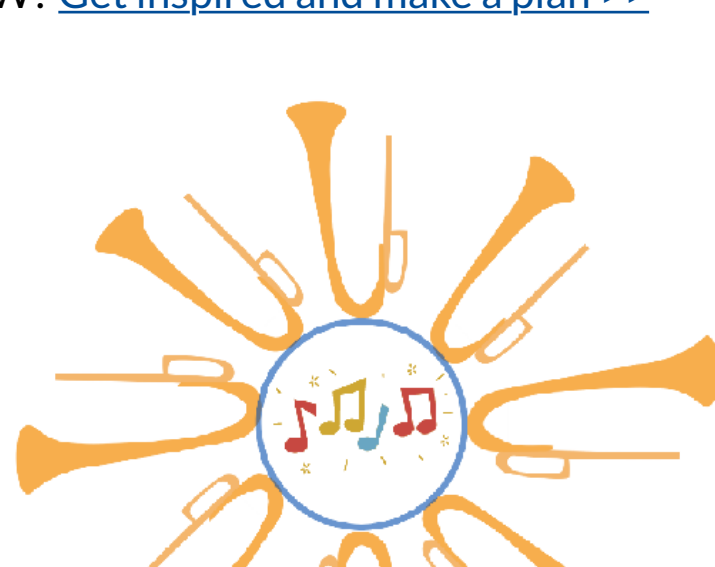
Bass Trombonist releases Solo Album
