CHARTER

of

INTERNATIONAL TROMBONE ASSOCIATION

The undersigned natural person or persons, having capacity to contract and acting as the incorporator or incorporators of a corporation under the Tennessee General Corporation Act, adopt the following charter for such corporation:

- 1. The name of the corporation is the <u>INTERNATIONAL</u> TROMBONE ASSOCIATION.
 - 2. The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. The address of the principal office of the corporation in the State of Tennessee shall be <u>Peabody School of Music</u>, <u>Nashville</u>, <u>Tennessee</u> 37203.
 - 4. The corporation is not for profit.
- 5. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To promote communcation between trombonists around the world; to improve the artistic level of performance, teaching, and literature associated with the trombone family; to function as a clearing house for trombone related ideas and information.

6. The corporation is to have members as set forth in its constitution under Article II, sections 1, 2, 3, and 4.

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- 7. Other provisions:
- (a) the board of directors shall be limited to those directors and (b) officers as specified by Article III of the constitution, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 and Article IV, officer's sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7.
- (c) All other provisions relating to such matters as regulation of internal affairs, provisions creating, dividing and regulating the powers of directors, officers or members, or any class of members, and provision for distribution of assets upon dissolution or final liquidation, etc., shall be governed by the provisions of Chapters 1 through 14 of the Tennessee General Corporation Act.
