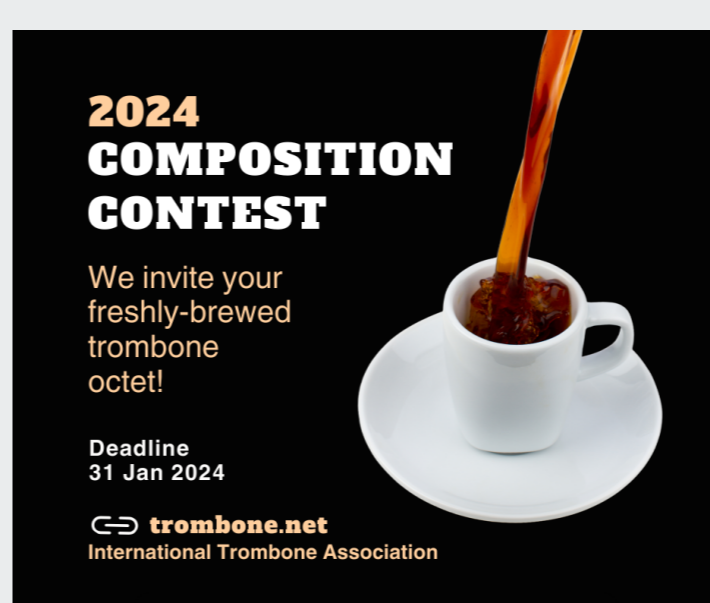
### ITA Composition Contest

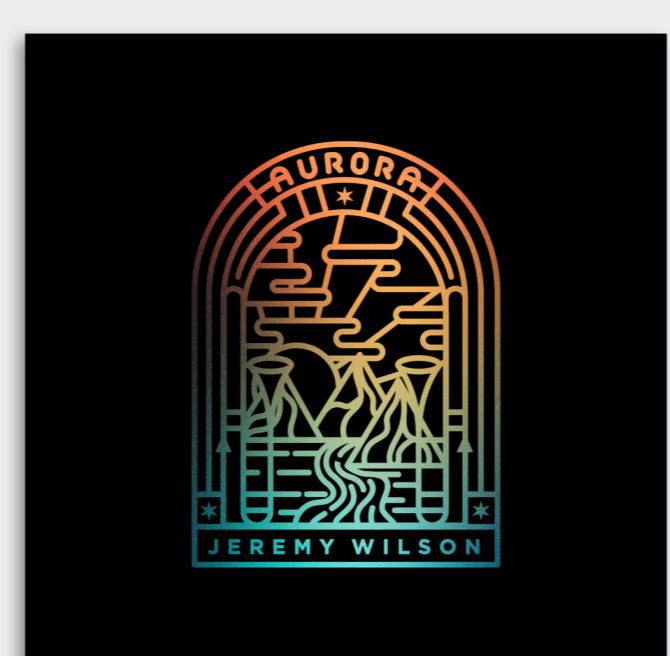
